

NCADA is seeking to hire a full-time professional counselor to provide substance use disorder assessments to both adolescents and adults. At times, this may also include working with caregivers and significant others. In addition to direct counseling and making referrals to the proper level of care, when appropriate, having the ability to identify and address behavioral, social and developmental problems is also required. The counselor will engage in one-to-one and sometimes conjoint counseling sessions, and provide educational programs to a variety of audiences. This position requires the counselor to travel among multiple locations in the St. Louis area.

The ideal candidate is flexible, is able to develop rapport with a wide variety of clients, has familiarity with substance use disorder and area resources for treating it, is comfortable with public speaking, and is willing to become part of the St. Louis area's #1 Top Workplace.

At minimum, the candidate must have a master's degree in social work, counseling or a related field. Licensure (LPC or LCSW) is preferred.
