

NCADA Substance Use Disorder Counselor

NCADA is looking for a skilled, professional counselor to provide substance use disorder assessments to both adolescents and adults at multiple locations in the St. Louis area. At times, this may also include working with caregivers and significant others. NCADA is not a treatment center and we have long prided ourselves on providing neutral, non-biased evaluations, unwedded to any one treatment approach or level of care.

So we are looking for someone who can quickly and accurately identify and address behavioral, social and developmental problems in addition to issues with alcohol or other drugs. The counselor will engage in one-to-one and sometimes conjoint counseling sessions which, when appropriate, may result in a referral to treatment or other community resources. Our counselors are sometimes asked to provide educational programs to a variety of audiences, so a phobia about public speaking might cause you to look elsewhere. This job does require a bit of driving to multiple locations in the St. Louis area, so having a reliable vehicle is important. The position does include mileage reimbursement.

The ideal candidate is flexible, willing to work 30 hours/week, able to develop rapport with a wide variety of clients, has familiarity with substance use disorder and area resources for treating it, is comfortable with public speaking, and is interested in becoming part of the St. Louis area's #1 Top Workplace. At minimum, the candidate must have a master's degree in social work, counseling or a related field. Licensure (LPC or LCSW) is preferred.
